

Title: A resolution benchmarking platform for confocal and STED microscopy

The **Resolution Benchmarking Platform** was developed as a collaboration between the Advanced Optical Microscopy Facility (**AOMF**) at the University Health Network in Toronto, and the Advanced Biolmaging Facility (**ABIF**) and Neuro Microscopy Core Facility (**NMCF**) both at McGill University in Montreal. Key input and data were also submitted from a cohort of **Early Adopters** from facilities and labs around the world.
